Please be advised that we have managed to consult with the Acting President of the Republic of South Africa, Deputy President Ramaphosa, duly authorised by the President, in his capacity as Head of the National Executive.

We are advised that the President and the Deputy President have consulted with some of the relevant persons in Government.

We hold instructions from our clients to afford your client an opportunity to meet with Government at the highest level, namely, with a delegation that will include either the President or the Deputy President or both of them.

We are instructed that this matter can best be handled through talks between our respective clients, which is our clients' preferred option at this stage. We are advised that our said clients do not believe that this issue can be satisfactorily resolved through litigation.

Our clients apologise for not having been in a position to meaningfully respond to your client's communication or afford your client a meeting earlier due to, inter alla, the pre and post-election campaign and their busy schedules and commitments, as previously advised. Please note that the President is still out of the country. However, our clients now have a mandate to meet with and talk to your client.

Kindly take instructions and advise if your client is amenable to our clients' proposal to have talks with them. If so, our clients will be available to meet with your client within a period of four (4) weeks.

In the event of your client agreeing thereto, we will revert with a confirmed date, time and venue for a meeting to be held during the month of August 2014, in
